REGULAR HEARING:

ITEM 3 BRIEFING AND RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AD-HOC COMMITTEE ON AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FRIONA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AND A SELECTED BUILDER FOR A RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT LOCATED AT TOWNSHIP 1-4, LOT 2.07 AC E OF EUCLID & N OF 15TH OF SEC 31, ACRES 2.07 (FLIPPIN) ALSO KNOWN AS 2.07 AC E OF EUCLID & N OF 15TH OF SEC 31

City council suggested that there be community input process to address any questions or concerns from those homeowners within a 200 ft. radius of the housing development. Public hearings will be held prior to the FEDC meeting scheduled on August 4th, 2022 and the City Council meeting on August 8, 2022. A walk thru will be conducted at the framing stage. The completion deadline has been extended to two years giving the contractors 6 months to complete each of the 4 stages.

Council members will request 2 to 3 letters of recommendation and the contractors will need to provide the financial resources on hand to make this project possible and the total cost of the project. The city has agreed to waive all permit fees. The builders will submit their final proposal on or before July 29,2022. The FEDC will meet on August 4, 2022 to take action to recommend a builder to the Friona City Council.
