ITEM 2 HEAR PUBLIC COMMENTS

Marissa Licerio addressed the board on how she spent the grant money she received from EDC. She will bring Emma an itemized listing of the total amount spent. Currently there are 7 children enrolled. Happy Tribe received a \$38,000 grant from the Texas Workforce. That money has not yet been spent. Marissa will bring Emma a projected cost of state approved inside and outside playground equipment. The EDC will meet again to approve her request.

ITEM 3 CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVAL OF THE FRIONA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION MINUTES OF OCTOBER 30TH, 2023

Holly Campbell made the motion to approve the minutes of October 30th, 2023, minutes. The second to the motion was made by Henry Clark and the motion was passed with a unanimous vote of the FEDC Board of Directors.

ITEM 4 CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVAL OF FIRST QUARTER FINANCIALS

Justin Jeter recommended that Emma look into what the bank is paying on a 12-month term for CD's.

Greg Lewellen made the motion to approve the first quarter financials. The second to the motion was made by Holly Campbell and the motion passed with a unanimous vote of the FEDC Board of Directors.

ITEM 5 SET APPLICATION DATES FOR STOREFRONT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM 2024

Emma is looking into perhaps implementing a different program next year. The EDC approved the amended dates for the program. Completed work with receipts must be in by September 16th, 2024. Andy suggested that the matching fund for \$5,000 be increased from \$1,500 to \$2,000. If EDC does not reach the limit of 10 local business owners, it is possible to increase the amount.

Andy Alexander made the motion to approve the amended dates for the storefront improvement program. Henry Clark made the second to the motion and the motion passed with a unanimous vote of the FEDC Board of Directors.

ITEM 6 UPDATE ON FRANKLIN BAKER PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Bryan Guymon sent a default letter and Franklin said he will pay \$100.00 a month beginning January 21st, 2024.

ITEM 7 UPDATE ON IDENTIFIED PROPERTIES FOR POTENTIAL DEVELOPMENT IN FRIONA

Wheelhouse Commercial Development reached out to the City of Friona inquiring about locations on Hwy 60 that could be developed. The board reviewed a Gap Analysis with a market outlook for Friona.
